#### **Conference Paper Guidelines**

The Conference Paper Submission Guidelines for the proceedings of the 39<sup>th</sup> International Conference of the Polymer Processing Society (PPS 39) have been published. Please use them to prepare your conference paper for its submission.

Take into account that the final date for the submission of Conference Papers is June 30<sup>th</sup>. Some General Format recommendations are:

- The document bust be in Word Format. The file name of the paper should comprise the abbreviated paper Title, and underscore, and the relevant symposium.
- The font should be Times New Roman, Size 12.
- Insert Page Number in the bottom right corner.
- Maintain 1.5 line Spacing with Justified alignment.
- The title and headings should be in bold and centered.
  - Apart from Prepositions and articles, all words in the title, headings, and subheadings should have their initial letters in uppercase.
- Paragraphs do not have indentation and should be separated by a line break.
- Utilize IEEE citation style.
